A big thank you to all that made our largest yearly fund raiser (Volksfest) a resounding success. To all the volunteers, organisers, helpers of all and any kind, thank you.



At the Torrens Parade Ground

It had been hoped that we would return to Elder Park, but Adelaide City Council decided that other major events held on either side of the planned dates for Volksfest would result in too heavy demand on the grounds and so Volksfest 2024 was held again at the Torrens Parade Ground.

Nevertheless, the weather was ideal for this setting. As occurred in 2022, the area at the southern end of the TPG (the Pioneer Women's Memorial Gardens) was an ideal setting for the café/BBQ, provide an area for the Club tent and merchandise and the band. The Three Valleys Gin company also set up their booth in this area.

We had a range of traders, some travelling from interstate with a range of VW parts, books, clothing and VW -themed decorative items. The traders were able to set up in a designated area immediately in front of the Drill Hall.

Vehicle numbers were a little down from that of previous years which was possibly due to Adelaide 500 also being held on the same day. Just over 100 vehicles were on display at Volksfest, primarily Beetles and Kombis, and there were a few Karmann Ghias, Type 3s, a hill climb car and kit cars, including the familiar Eurekas.

Entrants were able to vote for what they considered to be the Top 10 vehicles on display at Volksfest. The Top 10 winners were:


MIKE'S MUSINGS

Recently I was fortunate to have a drive in a new Porsche Macan T and, not surprisingly, I

really liked it. While the T is the next step up from the 'base' model, it still cost over \$100k in the car I was in because of various options including leather seats, the chrono pack and 21-inch wheels. Nevertheless, it still presents as a prestige car and is beautifully assembled (as it should be for the price!). But here's the thing for me and I'm sure this will make Porsche marketers cringe – I think this is an ideal car for older (senior) drivers who, on



occasions, like to hustle a car along yet need a car that is responsive, safe and has all the contemporary safety features just in case their reflexes aren't as responsive as they might





them from the unpredictable and sometimes challenging behaviour of some other There's lots drivers. adjustment in the front seats and you have a slightly raised driving position so if your knees, hips or back have lost some of their flexibility it's



easy to step in and out of this car, and there's a camera system which includes an overhead view so you don't have to twist your neck and shoulders. While the T 'only' has the 2-litre turbo motor, the car is still fast; 0–100km/h in 6.2 seconds – the Golf GTI takes 6.4 seconds (– but the Golf R will do it in 4.8 seconds). I guess it should be noted that these cars all share a version of this same engine. I kept the car in Normal but I could also have opted for Sport or even Sport + but it was a new car (and not mine) so I didn't try these modes – not really appropriate for suburban roads anyway. I quite like the design, too. The 'shark-like' front has the right proportions for this smaller SUV - I think this nose on the Cayenne is just too pronounced. We had a drive along the poorly maintained roads of Adelaide's north east suburbs (although are there any of Adelaide's roads that are well maintained these days?) and the ride was quite smooth even with the larger wheels. Yep, I really liked this car. There

I came across a promo for Ned Australian Whiskey which is a sponsor of Grove Racing which itself operates the Penrite Supercar (with David Reynolds and Matt Payne as drivers. You can see the "Ned' logo on the front spoiler of their Ford Mustang.) Now according to

was only one thing wrong with my drive of the Porsche Macan T - I had to give it back!



the advertising, what makes this whiskey special is that the in-car sounds coming from the Reynolds/ Payne car during laps of Bathurst have been played at volume to barrels of Ned Whiskey in a special sound-proof container for 2000 hours in a process the distillers call 'sound-ageing'. There's also a 'Retro' line where the barrels have been sound-aged with the sound of older Bathurst cars, and, in case you're sceptical, the company also produces a product called 'Start-Line' which is the same whiskey but not sound-aged so you can make the comparisons between the products and hopefully taste the difference that this process

produces. I'm not a distiller but I wonder if this process might work? Perhaps the vibrations caused by the engine timbre causes more whiskey molecules to come into contact with the wood in the barrels and this results in a more smooth and deeper taste? But then the questions which come to my mind are: what effect would it have with playing the sounds of my Kombi (NOT pictured!) motor for 2000 hours on whiskey? Would the 'whine' of a Formula E car work just as well? What about a Villers 2-stroke? How likely would



these sounds affect the aroma, palate and finish of the whiskey? Would a professional whiskey taster be able to say, 'hmm, not enough sound-ageing', or 'a very drinkable drop with deep bass exhaust notes'. I know there are club members who understand the distilling process in depth—I'd be interested in your views.



You might have seen similar stories on Rev (Channel 44) about where particular car companies have partnered with some Mediterranean island authorities to transform all mobility on an island to become emission-free and sustainable. Well, Volkswagen too is involved in such a venture on a Greek island in the Mediterranean called

Astypalea. As I understand it, the


charging infrastructure has been established and all authority vehicles are now electric (police, ambulance etc). From 2024, a 3-megawatt solar park and a battery storage system, will supply electric vehicles entirely with electricity generated from renewable sources and will also meet 60% of the island's total general energy needs. So far, the



island has mainly been supplied with electricity from diesel generators, which emit up to 5,000 tons of CO2 per year. The island, again with VW's support and assistance, has initiated a bus ride-sharing service and customers can also rent e-cars from Volkswagen as well as e-scooters from SEAT MÓ and e-bikes from Ducati. The booking is made via smartphone via an integrated app. There's an article in The Guardian, available online at https://www.theguardian.com/travel/2023/sep/19/greece-island-astypalea-electric-vehicles-holidays where a journalist describes her visit as tourist to this beautiful island and her experiences with e-travel. I wonder whether anyone has thought about such an initiative for any of the many islands around Australia to maintain and preserve their clean and green state? The adoption of such an initiative would require a significant change in mental mindset plus many \$\$ but we do seem to have an abundance of green energy sources (solar, wind and water). King Island, then Kangaroo Island, then Tasmania, then....?


THE MEMORIAL CRUISE




